

GUIDELINES FOR COVID-19
LINEDANCE CLASSES
JUNIPER RIDGE RESORT – 2020

All participants in line dance classes at Juniper Ridge Resort for the 2020 season are required to adhere to all guidelines set out by Governor Ducey and the Juniper Ridge Resort Board of Directors.

Please understand that the Governor's and Board of Director's directive is subject to change at any time and subsequent directives may require a change to these guidelines and procedures that may include closures or additional social distancing restrictions or could include additional easing of restrictions.

In addition to the above-mentioned guidelines, some additional guidelines for participating in the line dance classes will be as follows:

1. Sign-in for class will be required. In the event someone in class contracts the disease, contact tracing can be accomplished;
2. Bring hand sanitizer and disinfectants (I will have both available as well). Be sure to clean any surfaces you touch, wash your hands and do not touch your face or eyes after touching any surfaces in the lodge;
3. Maintain physical distancing – 6 ft – while dancing and/or visiting;
4. Face Masks are suggested but not required;
5. Temperature taking either at home or at class. I will have a thermometer available;
6. Do not come to class if you are experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 as recognized by the CDC or have been exposed to anyone with COVID-19; and
7. Do not come to class if you are experiencing signs of any other kind of illness or virus.
